

# GUEST *Welcome*

## UPON ARRIVAL

### **PARKING AND BAG DROP**

- There are two locations to park your vehicle. The upper parking lot is closest to the Golf Shop, its bag drop, and to the Men's locker room. The lower parking lot leads to the clubhouse bag drop and is nearest to the dining rooms.

### **REGISTRATION**

- Please register at the Golf Shop upon arrival. The staff will ensure that you are directed to the appropriate locker room, where you can change into your golf attire.

### **LOCKERS**

- There are guest lockers available. The locker attendants will assist you in finding a locker.

## DRESS REGULATIONS

**OUR DRESS CODE IS REQUIRED THROUGHOUT THE CLUB PROPERTY,  
INCLUDING THE PARKING LOTS.**

### **Ladies**

- The length of golf shorts, skirts, skorts or dresses must be mid thigh or longer.
  - Pants, regular or Capri, may be worn. All of the above must be tailored, but not skin tight.
  - Collared golf shirts may be worn with, or without, sleeves, but must cover the shoulders.
  - Crew neck shirts must be worn with sleeves. All shirts may be fitted, but not skin tight.
- Miniskirts, tennis skirts, short shorts, jeans, yoga pants, sweatpants, gym pants, leggings, sweatshirts, tank tops and T-shirts are not acceptable.

### **Men**

- Slacks or Bermuda-length shorts with knee-length stockings.
- Collared golf shirts (including turtle and mock turtle necks) must be worn tucked in at the waist. Sweatshirts, T-shirts or jeans are not acceptable.

### **Juniors & Guests**

- The above dress regulations apply to all Junior Members, Guests, female or male.

### **Shoes**

- Golf shoes should either be spikeless or fitted with soft spikes.

### **In the clubhouse**

#### **Hats**

- Hats are not to be worn in the clubhouse.

- Golf attire is permitted in all areas during the day.
- In the evening, formal attire (jacket and tie for men and appropriate attire for ladies) is required in the Grier room, living room, garden veranda, gardens. Formal attire is also required at dinners following Club golf events where indicated. Juniors shall adhere to the same regulations. Guests Members are to ensure that their guests observe all dress regulations. The Secretary Manager and the Golf Shop Staff are to ensure that visitors are aware of and observe these regulations.

*If you are unsure of the appropriateness of your attire, please consult the Golf Shop or Secretary Manager, who can be of assistance. The Golf Shop carries a full range of clothing in the event that your attire does not conform.*

## PACE OF PLAY

- Players should play without delay. No player should take a shot until the players in front are out of range.
- If a match fails to keep pace, and it is apparent that those ahead are moving well and those behind are waiting on each shot, the players behind must be waved through.
- Members and guests must observe these rules and all other rules of golf etiquette, as found in the R.C.G.A Rules of Golf.

## CELLULAR PHONES AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES

- The use of all mobile devices anywhere on club property is strictly prohibited, except in the phone booth adjacent to the Men's Bar, or upstairs in the club boardroom.
- We strongly suggest that you leave your phone in your car.

## DIRECTION & MAP

### **From Trudeau Airport**

- Take Highway 20 East to Exit 68 South
- This brings you to Autoroute 15 South/Autoroute 20 East to take the Champlain bridge

### **From Champlain Bridge:**

1. Follow Highway 10 East, towards Sherbrooke,
  2. Take Exit #11–Highway 30 East, towards Sorel
  3. Take Exit #76 –Follow the signs for Route 116 East, towards Beloeil
  4. Follow Route 116 East through two sets of lights

### **From Victoria Bridge:**

1. Follow Route 112 East until it becomes Route 116
  2. Follow Route 116 East until you reach Highway 30
  3. Stay on Route 116 East through two sets of lights
- ... See **MAP section** for additional directions.

### From Jacques Cartier Bridge:

1. Keep to your right on Route 134 West (Blvd. Taschereau)
  2. Take the exit after the second overpass towards Route 112 / Route 116 East, towards Beloeil
  3. Follow Route 116 East until you reach Highway 30
  4. Stay on Route 116 East through two sets of lights

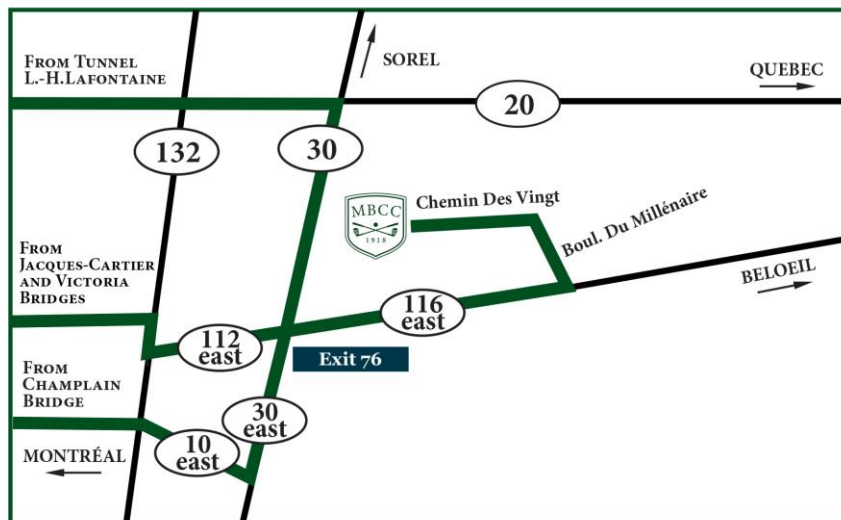
### From L.-H. Lafontaine Tunnel:

1. Follow the Highway 20 East, towards Quebec
  2. Take the Exit #98 towards Highway 30 West, towards Chateauguay
  3. Take the Exit #76 towards Route 116 East, towards Beloeil
  4. Follow the Route 116 East through two sets of lights

### MAP section

1. At the third set of lights, turn left on Blvd. du Millenaire,
2. At the end of this road (about 300m), turn left on Chemin des Vingt.
3. Go to the end of the road and follow the private road to your right.
